Reopening Good Shepherd

On June 21, Good Shepherd had its first in-person worship service since March 8. 64 people attended this first service back, praising God together and adhering to some new guidelines. These new guidelines were created to provide a safe environment for all, especially the most vulnerable to severe illness from Covid-19—our elderly members and those with underlying medical conditions. Some of the key guidelines include:

- Wearing a mask during the service.
- Humming in place of singing.
- Being escorted out of the service by the ushers, beginning at the back of the church.
- Contributing online or placing offerings in the designated box in the narthex.
- Taking your bulletin home with you or disposing in the garbage.
- Informing the office in advance if you intend to attend Sunday worship.

06.10.2020 reopening letter. As guidelines may change, we will continue to keep you informed.

As we come back to worship and gather in small groups, we ask you to extend grace, patience, and love to your neighbor. Please respect individual decisions and understand that not everyone is on the same page in regards to resuming in-person worship and generally reengaging in society. The enemy would enjoy it if our church became divided and our mission hindered, so let's not give him this pleasure.

Tentatively, Pastor Tim will be back on Sunday, July 5 to lead us in worship and we will have communion on July 5.
