## Pastoral Call Update

A Congregational Meeting was held on Sunday, August 15th. The purpose of this meeting was for the Call Committee to present Pastor Phillip Schultz as a candidate for a pastoral call from Good Shepherd. Ray Vogel reviewed the committee's work to date. Discussion was had and ballots were cast. Ultimately, it was a unanimous decision that Good Shepherd extend a call to Pastor Phil. Pastor Phil agreed to consider the call.

A second Congregational Meeting was held on Sunday, August 29th for the congregation to approve the financial package. This package was not yet finalized at the August 15th meeting. Membership voted to approve the financial package.

Pastor Phil has received the call documents. Please keep Pastor Phil and his family in your prayers as he prayerfully considers the call extended to him by Good Shepherd. Pray for St. Luke Lutheran in Cheektowaga, NY, as they learn their pastor has received and is considering a call to Good Shepherd. Pray for Good Shepherd as we anxiously await a decision by Pastor Phil. As Pastor Barry said in a sermon this summer, 'God works all things together for good.' We continue to pray for His guidance and for patience, understanding that a new pastor for Good Shepherd will be identified in His time.
